Revenue for the guarter ended 30 June 2013 ("1Q FY2014") grew by 14% over the corresponding quarter last year to \$154.7 million. This was achieved due to an expanded retail network and increased marketing activities.

Gross margins were marginally lower at 21.6% (1Q FY2013: 22.2%) due to a more competitive marketplace. Operating expenses were higher due to increased salaries and rentals.

Profit after tax was \$9.1 million compared to \$9.8 million for the previous corresponding quarter.

As at 30 June 2013, consolidated net assets were \$335.1 million or \$1.43 per share.
